ORANGE COUNTY, CA (January 25, 2021) Supervisor Lisa Bartlett issued the following statement in response to the State's decision to lift the Regional Stay-At-Home Order:

“The State’s decision to lift the Regional Stay at Home Order is a much-needed step in the right for direction for businesses and families who have been decimated by overly burdensome lockdowns,” said Supervisor Bartlett.

“The fact remains that we can safely keep businesses open while simultaneously taking common sense measures to mitigate the spread of the virus – it does not have to be a choice of one or the other. To ensure we can continue moving towards a fully open economy, state and local governments must stay focused on testing, hospital resources and staffing, and vaccine distribution. One of our top priorities must be preventing any further lockdowns.”
